Logging into Nest www.nestpensions.org.uk

Log into your NEST account

NEST is a secure system and you can only access it if you have your own NEST username and password. If you've already set up your NEST or if you're new to NEST and haven't set up your online account yet, you can sign up now using the option below.

If you haven't previously logged into your account you will need to sign up. To do this you will need to provide the following information;

- Date of Birth
- National Insurance Number
- *Nest ID number (your Nest welcome pack will have been sent via post after 12 weeks of employment).

Don't worry if you haven't got the Nest ID number- please instead click on don't have Nest ID and ensure you provide DOB and NI.

If you have already logged in previously please just add your user name and password.

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Do you want to check contributions made to your NEST pot?

You can see details of contributions made to your NEST retirement pot, including a breakdown of charges and any tax relief.

You can pay more into your retirement pot by making regular additional contributions here. These will be on top of any contributions made by you or your employers from your earnings.

Contributions made by your employer

Here you can view any contributions your employer is making for you. If you were expecting to see other employers, not listed here, you should:

- Check with your delegates. If you have delegated access to your NEST account to another person, check if they've stopped contributions from the missing employer.
- Contact the missing employer to find out if they've stopped making contributions for you.

How to start making contributions if your employer is using NEST

If you want to start or re-start making contributions to NEST please speak to your employer. They may have a legal duty to make contributions for you if you ask them to. You can find out more about your employer's duties to you at [NEST for savers](#).

How can you change the amount of your contributions?

If you want to change your contributions you'll need to speak to your employer. Employers may offer a range of contribution rates, so find out if you could be getting more. Only they can make this change.

One way to increase your contributions is by making [regular additional contributions](#) or [single additional contributions](#).

How can you stop making contributions?

To stop contributions made by an employer click on the [Stop contributions](#) button and follow the steps. This will stop all contributions made by this employer. This includes their employer contributions and contributions they are making on your behalf from your earnings.

You will need to repeat this process for each employer you want to stop making contributions.

The percentage given for "your contributions" includes tax relief. If you are eligible for tax relief, the actual amount you will pay will be less than this percentage.
